Keeping kids and families healthy and happy

Healthy families are happy families.

Families who get health care have kids who miss less school and parents who miss less work.

Health care coverage is an important way to ensure everyone stays healthy!

For many families, health coverage is not available through their jobs — either because it's not offered or it's too expensive.

Healthy Start & Healthy Families can help your family stay happy, healthy and strong.



Who can get Healthy Start & Healthy Families?

Healthy Start is free health coverage for kids from birth to age 19 and pregnant women who qualify based on family income.

Healthy Families provides health coverage for the entire family — parents and children.

A family's income will determine if they are eligible for Healthy Start or Healthy Families.

What will it cost me?

Families meeting Healthy Start & Healthy Families income guidelines can get coverage for free or at very low cost. Some services for some family members may have co-pays of \$1 to \$3.

What services are covered?

Healthy Start & Healthy Families covers these services:

Doctor Visits
Pregnancy Services
Prescriptions
Mental Health
Substance Abuse

Hospital Care
Dental Care
Vision Services
Immunizations
And more!

How do I apply?

You can call the Medicaid Consumer Hotline: 1-800-324-8680 to request an application. The Hotline staff can help you fill out the form and mail it to you for your signature. The Hotline is open seven days a week.

You can also visit: jfs.ohio.gov/ohp to download an application. You will need to print it out and mail it to your local county office of job & family services.

What about working families?

Working families can qualify. The family size and income will determine if the family is eligible for Healthy Start for their kids or Healthy Families for the entire family.

A portion of certain monthly expenses (e.g., child care, child support) is not counted as a part of monthly income.
